Public Goods Examples - Examples of public goods, a list of public goods. Because of this most public goods are managed by the government (think of the road and education system, national defense, clean water and air, those sorts of things). But some public goods are still managed by private firms. Because they are non-excludable, firms cannot charge people to use them. Public goods that are available everywhere are sometimes referred to as global public goods. Examples of public good knowledge is mens, womens and youth health awareness, environmental issues, maintaining biodiversity, sharing and interpreting contemporary history with a cultural lexicon, particularly about protected cultural heritage sites and monuments, popular and entertaining tourist attractions, libraries and universities. And these public goods are also all subject to congestion when too many people use them, so that the quality of the good may be affected by adding more users. Additional examples of public goods that are subject to congestion are a bridge, a public swimming pool, and an airport. Examples of Public Goods. Both a public bridge and street lighting exhibit characteristics of a public good. National defence. If you protect the country from invasion, it benefits everyone in the country. Street lighting. If you provide light at night, you can't stop anyone consuming the good.
